

«This underwater landscape with water lilies, a small school of perch and the sun shining through the vegetation make a beautiful scene where we would love to swim. »






«The mating toads make a nice line to the red leaf. It is not normal to see so much negative space in a behavior photo, but in this case it works well.»




































## Class C2 – Wide angle without model


3rd Place BJØRNAR NYGÅRD







































## Class C3 – Wide angle without model
