CMAS 6th FREE DIVING OUTDOOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 will be done at Kaş, Antalya, Turkey.

1. COMPETITIONS

There will be **CWT with Mono/Bi-Fins, Free Immersion, CWT No Fins and CWT with Bi-Fins** competitions for Seniors .

- Day 1 CWT
- Day 2 FIM
- Day 3 Rest day
- Day 4 CNF
- Day 5 CWT-BF

Parallel to the above categories, there will also be CMAS 2nd Free Diving World Outdoor Master Categories Championship - 2022 together with CMAS 6th FREE DIVING OUTDOOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2022.

For Masters registration you have to follow the three steps registration:

The registration is complete and valid only after the payment of 50 euro.

3) Final, you follow the instructions at section 2 below, APPLICATIONS & PAYMENTS

Per OUTDOOR RULES DOCUMENT CA 218 2022/01; Article 1.1.7.1 The official competitions are organized for men and women. The senior category corresponds to ages from over 18 to 49. Athletes who are at least 50 years old belong to the master's group, which is further subdivided in categories 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-70 and over 70. Master athletes may, if they wish, compete in the senior's category. This choice will be mandatory for the whole ongoing season.

- LATE PAYMENTS ARE SUBJECT TO 10% INCREASE AFTER 31 AUGUST 2022.

- The ones that will not stay in the organization's hotel are subject to pay 500 Euro for participation. Please note that in such case the participants can't attend the daily meals in the central hotel (breakfast, lunch and dinner) and they also can't access the domestic transfers to the boats from their place of stay.
- Party night and one day cultural tour To Be Defined later on.

3. SPECIAL NOTES

- 1. As subject to change according to the latest status of pandemy things to be done will be declared 2 weeks ago from the competition.
- 2. The event is open to the athletes aged 18 and over and belonging to National Teams fully complying with the provisions of CMAS Regulations.





- **3.** National Teams may be made up of a minimum of one to a maximum of six athletes for each men's competition and a minimum of one to a maximum of six athletes for each women's competition.
- **4.** National Teams will have to bring with them three flags of their countries, 2x1m in size and a CD containing their national anthem and they shoul deliver those at the registration.
- **5.** Turkish Underwater Sports Federation (TSSF), CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Technical Delegates are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. The organizer ensures the presence of medical assistance.
- 6. The rules of competitions applied will be:

- 7. All participating athletes shall accept and follow the international rules of WADA.
- 8. Athletes must be in possession of:
 - The original entry form signed by the Federation's authorised person;
 - Valid CMAS Apnea sports licence;
 - ID document.

Athletes that fail to provide the above documents will not be allowed to take part in the competitions, and their participation fee will not be refunded.

9. Classifications and Prize-giving shall be performed in agreement with CMAS Procedures.

4. EVENT SCHEDULE

The Draft Program of the event is as follows:

- 1st October 2022 Arrivals, registrations.
- Official training on 2nd October 2022 from 08:45 to 12:00 departing at 08:00 from port.
- The opening ceremony will take place on 02 October 2022 at 7 p.m., in Main Square, Kaş Downtown.
- Prize-giving ceremonies will be held in Main Square, Kaş Downtown at the conclusion of each competition session.
- The closing ceremony will take place on Friday 07 October 2022 straight after the Prizegiving ceremony for the last heat of the competition at the Main Square, Kaş Downtown.

5. ADDITIONAL TRAINING

- 1- There will be CWT with Mono/Bi-Fins, CWT with Bi-Fins, CWT No Fins and FIM training starting approx. 1 week before.
- **2-** The registration will be done as the same conditions for competition registration.
- 3- The athletes have to pay 40 Euro/Person/Training session if they are on the boat even they





don't dive. 1 Assistant on the boat who won't dive will be free on the boat.

- 4- The training dates & other issues;
 - a. Some free diver safeties is included and others are expected by the athlete's team,
 - **b.** Common pre competition training will be planned from September 22th u ntil September 28th at 07:00-10:00 AM (one session a day),
 - **c.** The competition boat and the performance & emergency system will be available.

7. CLIMATE

Kaş is one of the southernmost points in Turkey—indeed, it lies on about the same latitude with North African city of Tunis—so be ready for warm weather conditions:

8. HOW TO GET THERE

The organization will transfer you. But if you want to do your own plan; Kaş is halfway between Dalaman Airport (140 km) and Antalya Airport (192 km) and a fair distance from both, so it avoids excessive package trade. There are various ways to get to Kaş from these airports. The easiest way, and the most expensive, is by taxi. You can hire a taxi in the airport (generally more expensive - should be fixed price of 60-90 EURO), or you can book a transfer from the hotel where you will be staying or from a local travel agency in Kaş (around 60 EURO). You can take a bus or dolmuş (a shared/bus taxi of usually 12 passengers) however they stop in every small village along the way which takes more time.

There are also direct overnight bus services between Istanbul and Kaş, a rather inexpensive way of getting to and from the capital. Bus services in Turkey are very modern and generally excellent and, if you want to get to Istanbul, you may prefer spending the night in the bus and waking up in Istanbul the next morning rather than wasting a whole day traveling to the airports for a local flight.

The bus station (*otogar*) is located right at the centre of town, on the side of main square.

The savvy traveler should remember that when traveling into Kaş, there are several national holidays to keep in mind as they can cause delays in travel, traffic congestion, booked up accommodations and crowded venues.

9. GET AROUND

Kaş is a small town, and you can walk anywhere within 10 minutes. Scooters are available for rent around town (10-20 Euro per day, depending on season), if you just can't be bothered. Minibuses run around the Peninsula of Çukurbağ, known in Turkish as *Yarım Ada*, which is a few kilometers away and where most hotels have their own terrace "beaches" open to the public (as long as beverages or food are consumed from their beach bars). Taxis to the peninsula can be costly, at least US \$10 each way.

Transportation in Turkey is excellent. You can take a minibus *(or dolmuş)* up to the village of Çukurbağ, about 10 km directly above and behind Kaş and on to places such as Kekova or Kalkan on either side of Kaş.
